## Drop Off at Town Hall

Bring your accepted plastic bag / film recyclable items down to Town Hall. We weigh it and log it with Trex. When we log 500 pounds, the Township gets a free park bench! We have received three benches already and they are in use at the Town Hall and at the Frelinghuysen Forest Preserve!

#### OR THESE

- ✗ Degradable/compostable bags or film packaging
- ✗ Pre-washed salad mix bags
- ✗ Hot dog or meat wrap packaging

- ✗ Six-pack rings
- ✗ PPE- Gloves, masks, or protective wear
- ✗ Pool covers
- ✗ Lamination film
- ✗ Silage and hay bags

- ✗ Vinyl shower curtains or tablecloths
- ✗ Bedding or linen packaging
- ✗ Shiny, crinkly films like floral wrap
- ✗ Backyard ice rinks

#### DON'T SEE YOUR ITEM ON THE LIST?

Try these tests to see if your plastic is acceptable or not.

**See if the package will stretch when you pull it.** If yes, it can be included. If it tears like paper, then please don't put in the bin.

**Is the package shiny or does it make a crinkly/crunchy sound in your hand?** If yes, do NOT recycle in the NexTrex® bin.

### What can be recycled?

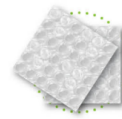
*All plastic must be clean, dry and free of food residue.*

Bread bags



Bubble wrap



Dry cleaning bags



Ziploc & other reclosable food storage bags



Cereal bags



Case overwrap



Salt bags



Newspaper sleeves



Ice bags



Plastic shipping envelopes



Pallet wrap & stretch film



Wood pellet bags



Produce bags

If it is not on the above list but is **numbered 2 or 4** it can be recycled. Any other numbered items are **NOT** recyclable through this program.

## Please Do Not Bring Unacceptable Items

Please only bring the items that are on the list above. If unacceptable items are brought down, we have to sort through and throw them out - so please don't make extra work for our volunteers!
