To Frelinghuysen Township Residents:

Pursuant to the Proclamation of Local Disaster and Emergency signed by the Mayor and the OEM on March 16, 2020 relating to the COVID-19 pandemic, and subsequent Original, Amended and Supplemental Frelinghuysen Township Directives for the Implementation of the Governor's Executive Orders 107, 108, and Administrative Order 2020-4, all Frelinghuysen Township buildings were closed to the general public. All meetings or gatherings of outside entities using Township facilities were also cancelled and in-person meetings of Township entities were limited. Pursuant to the Governor's Executive Order 242, and in consultation with the OEM, as of June 14, 2021 Town Hall is reopened to those members of the public who have business to conduct there. Meetings and gatherings of outside entities using Township facilities is permitted as arranged with the Township in advance pursuant to established policies and procedures and consistent with state guidance. The Township Committee will hold its Regular Committee Meetings in person at Town Hall with no access by Zoom as advertised and noticed pursuant to the Open Public Meetings Act. Township Committee Work Sessions and Special Meetings will still be held via Zoom format only as advertised and noticed pursuant to the Open Public Meetings Act. All other Township Committees, Boards and Commissions may start holding in-person meetings commencing on June 14, 2021, except the Land Use Board which may commence holding in-person meetings on August 2, 2021. Other than the Land Use Board, the Chairpersons of the other Committees and Boards may decide whether or not to continue holding meetings by Zoom, hold meetings in-person, or a hybrid of both. Public notice, where required, should be properly made. These conditions will be subject to reevaluation from time to time by the Mayor and the OEM as circumstances dictate.
