To All Frelinghuysen Residents:

Pursuant to the Proclamation of Local Disaster and Emergency signed by the Mayor and the OEM on March 16, 2020 relating to the COVID-19 pandemic, until further notice, all Frelinghuysen Township buildings will be closed to the general public, with the exception for public meetings of the Township Committee. All meetings or gatherings of outside entities using Township facilities are also cancelled. All members of the public having business with the Township may phone with any inquiries, 908-852-4121, or to make an appointment. All meetings of all Township bodies, committees, commissions and boards, are hereby cancelled until further notice, with the exception of previously scheduled meetings of the Township Committee. The Township Committee reserves the right to hold its meetings by alternative forms of communication pursuant to N.J.S.A. 10:4-8(b). Township recreational fields and facilities are also closed to organized athletics, but remain open to individual members of the public. The Clerk, DPW, Township contractors, CFO, Tax Collector, are expected to report for work at their regularly scheduled dates and times. The Construction Official, Township Engineer, Township Planner, Township Attorney, Tax Assessor, and Zoning Officer are expected to work remotely if and when possible. Any employee or agent who does not feel well, is sick or has health concerns, should not report to work, and should use sick days. Until further notice, the Township shall take whatever steps are necessary and appropriate to comply with Governor Murphy's directive that public gatherings be limited to ten (10) persons or less. These conditions will be subject to reevaluation from time to time by the Mayor and the OEM as circumstances dictate.
