Dear Frelinghuysen Resident,

I wanted to take this opportunity to inform you that the Township Committee, OEM, Clerk, DPW and Township employees are working for you during this time of crisis. I thank all of them for their respective efforts.

Myself and Nick Pachnos, the Township's OEM, are on daily phone conferences with County authorities and other Mayors and OEMs regarding the COVID-19 pandemic. We have also been involved in conference calls with Federal, State and County authorities regularly, including with Congressman Gottheimer, who has been very responsive. Some of the information we are given is not for public consumption, although the Township Committee is kept advised of all developments. The information which we can share with the public will be posted on the Frelinghuysen OEM website as a central repository for all the COVID-19 public information we can share, as well as other OEM information, including weather events and the like.

I would also refer you to the policies and information contained in the COVID-19 section of the Township's website, particularly the memos of March 18 and 22 which implement for Frelinghuysen Township the best practices relating to the COVID-19 crisis based on the directives we have received from Governor Murphy through his Executive Orders and through Administrative Orders from other State authorities. Also on the website are the OEM's Letter of March 15, 2020, and the Proclamation of a Local Disaster and Emergency. The State website *covid19.nj.gov* and the County website *co.warren.nj.us* have significant information on the COVID-19 situation.

It is my hope that Frelinghuysen Township and the nation will be back to normal soon.
